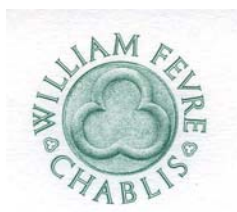

<b>Terra Andina 'Altos' Syrah – Cabernet Sauvignon</b> Naturally low-yielding soils from the Maipo Valley help the grapes achieve great concentration of flavour. The wine is rich and well balanced, with a long and pleasant finish.	693895	\$18.95

<b>Beaune du Château 1<sup>er</sup> Cru Blanc 2006 (Bouchard Père &amp; Fils)</b> <b>Burghound:</b> 88 A ripe and pure nose of chardonnay fruit and white flowers is trimmed in a deft touch of wood that complements the round, generous and nicely concentrated flavors that possess a succulent, even juicy quality on the mildly one-dimensional finish. <b>Meursault Les Clous 2006 (Domaine Bouchard Père &amp; Fils)</b> <b>Burghound:</b> 90 This offers a small step up in aromatic purity and refinement with a beautifully elegant and airy mix of orchard fruit, nuts and acacia blossom that introduces rich, full and sweet flavors that retain a fine sense of detail on the strikingly intense, mineral suffused finish that is even longer than the preceding wine.	661322	\$52.95
<b>Meursault Genevrières 2006 (Domaine Bouchard Père &amp; Fils)</b> <b>Burghound:</b> 93 A very deftly wooded nose, where it's clear that the oak treatment will be rapidly integrated, sets off pure, expressive and equally exotic fruit aromas that are even spicier while serving as a dramatic introduction for the detailed, focused and almost painfully intense flavors that possess a tangy and driving finish that does a slow build from the mid-palate on back. <b>Beaune Teurons 1<sup>er</sup> Cru 2006 (Domaine Bouchard Père &amp; Fils) red</b> <b>Burghound.com:</b> 89 "A discreet soupçon of wood sets off an at once prettier yet more serious nose of layered and pure earthy pinot fruit that possesses fine aromatic depth and this depth continues onto the textured, intense and mouth coating medium-bodied flavors that are very Teurons in terms of their taut muscularity, all wrapped in a firm finish that is admirably persistent. There is very good underlying material and this could surprise to the upside. A classic Teurons."	653675	\$53.95
<b>Volnay Caillerets Ancienne Cuvee Carnots 2004 (Domaine Bouchard Père &amp; Fils)</b> <b>Burghound.com:</b> 92 "This is the ripest wine to this point and while not jammy, there is an extract of cassis element to the nose plus a hint of framing wood. The flavors are richer and fuller than those of the Taillepieds yet more complex, powerful and they exude a better sense of overall harmony, particularly on the powerful yet refined finish. <b>Beaune Greves Vigne de L'Enfant Jesus 2004 (Monopole Bouchard Père &amp; Fils)</b> <b>Burghound.com:</b> 92 "Fans of this wine will notice a good deal more wood influence than normal but the good news is that it appears to also possess the requisite stuffing to successfully integrate it with time in bottle. The nose is earthy but fresh with excellent density and volume, culminating in an explosively powerful finish. More importantly for a firmly structured wine like this, the supporting tannins are ripe and this too should reward extended cellaring".	972554	\$81.95
<b>Beaune Greves Vigne de L'Enfant Jesus 2006 (Monopole Bouchard Père &amp; Fils)</b> <b>Burghound:</b> 92 Interestingly, Prost elected to serve this last, which means after the Clos de Bèze and I must say that it did not suffer unduly despite coming after a string of <i>grands crus</i> . A complex, fresh and layered nose of red berry fruits, spice and earth merges gracefully into rich, full, sweet and intense red cherry-infused flavors that are vibrant and unusually powerful while wrapped in a focused, mouth coating and superbly well balanced finish brimming with dry extract. <b>William Fevre Vaillons 1er Cru 2006</b> <b>Tanzer:</b> 88-90 "Aromas of lime, white flowers and mint. Sweeter and creamier than the Montmains, conveying more of a sense of structure and size but less elegant in style. Rich, layered, broad and classically dry."	700369	\$42.00
<b>William Fevre Fourchaume 1er Cru</b> <b>Burghound:</b> 90-93 "A subtle trace of wood frames elegant and pure of yellow and green fruit aromas nuanced by a touch of quinine and white flower that complements well the big, rich and full flavors that possess both power and real size plus a long mineral-infused finish."	87221	\$42.00
<b>William Fevre Beauroy 1er Cru 2006 – Classics</b> <b>Burghound:</b> 88-90 "Here the nose is ever so slightly riper and conveys well that this is a Chablis with a mix of green and yellow fruit with a background hint of seashore that leads to big and muscled flavours that possess excellent vivacity and while this isn't elegant (Beauroy rarely is), it's very Chablis and offers an attractive personality. **Chateau La Nerthe 'Tradition' Blanc 2006**

Parker: 91 "The 2006 Chateaufeuf du Pape Tradition blanc (51% Roussanne, 32% Grenache Blanc, and 17% Clairette and Bourboulenc) is a stunning effort aged in tank (70%) and wood (30%). It offers a beautiful nose of flowers, citrus, white currants, and rose petals. Medium-bodied with crisp acidity, this long, rich, impressively textured white should drink well for 5-6 years."

**Chateau La Nerthe 'Tradition' Rouge 2005**

Parker: 90 "The 2005 Chateaufeuf du Pape Tradition (50% Grenache, 31% Syrah, and the rest Mourvedre and Cinsault) exhibits a deep ruby/purple color along with a gorgeously sweet perfume of cassis, black cherries, smoke, roasted herbs, and licorice. It is soft, round, full-bodied, opulent, and accessible, which is somewhat out of character for this virile/masculine and tannic vintage. The 2005 Tradition should drink beautifully for 10-15 years.

Wonderfully balanced, with bright acids framing the apple, pear and citrus fruit flavors. This shows an almost saline quality and a long, mineral-infused finish. No oak here. Score - 91. The only white wine made by famous Spanish winemaker Alvaro Palacios, at his family-owned Rioja property, <i>Placet</i> is made solely from the indigenous Spanish grape variety Viura. Always produced in very low quantities, this unique wine exhibits a soft golden color and aromas of white flowers such as magnolia and jasmine, accompanied by ripe fruit such as pineapple, pear and honeydew melon. On the palate it is both voluptuous and vibrant with notable minerality, good acidity and a long finish.		
<b>Palacios Remondo 'La Montesa' 2005, Rioja</b>	674572	\$23.95
Alvaro Palacios is the embodiment of the promise and spirit of new Spanish winemaking. He immediately injected new life into the Riojan property of Herencia Remondo by dramatically reducing yields in the vineyards. He concentrates on two wines for this property, the high-end Propiedad and this finely tuned Crianza, La Montesa. Filled with dark fruits, cloves, fresh herbs and smoky oak, this Crianza is well made and perfectly balanced. The snappy acids and ripe tannins support the fruit aromas and flavours with precision.		
<b>Palacios Remondo 'Propiedad' 2005, Rioja</b>	597880	\$41.95
<b>Parker: 91</b> "The 2005 Propiedad is composed of 60% Garnacha and 40% Tempranillo aged for 14 months in mostly French oak and was bottled unfiltered. Dark ruby-colored, it presents an enticing perfume of smoke, pencil lead, spice box, flowers, black cherry, and blackberry. Medium to full-bodied, the wine delivers plenty of ripe fruit, excellent balance, and enough structure to evolve for 1-2 years. However, this elegant wine can be enjoyed now and over the next 8-10 years.		
<b>Alvaro Palacios Les Terrasses 2006, Priorat</b>	977843	\$39.95
Due to its extraordinary quality and attractive price, Les Terrasses (30% Garnacha, 60% Cariñena, and 10% Cabernet Sauvignon) has acquired a passionate following. <b>Decendientes de J. Palacios 2006, Bierzo</b>	675207	\$25.95
<b>Parker: 91</b> The 2006 Petalos del Bierzo is purple-colored with a fragrant nose of violets, lavender, mulberry, and blueberry. Ripe, supple, and sweetly fruited, it will evolve for 2-3 years and drink well through 2015. This estate was started in 1998 by Alvaro Palacios. It has steep hillside vineyards and 60-100 year old vines planted in 100% Mencia, a varietal indigenous to Bierzo, a cool-climate D.O
