Fragrant aromatics (spring flowers, red and blue fruits) are followed by a wine with excellent ripeness, sweet fruit, velvety tannins, and loads of complexity.	218941	\$59.95
El Alma de Jonata 2007, Santa Ynez – V Parker: 97 The finest Cabernet Franc to emerge south of San Francisco... Ethereal floral notes intermixed with notions of black raspberries, blueberries, and graphite are present in the aromas and flavors. Although it exhibits noteworthy concentration as well as endearing texture, richness, and intensity, it is not heavy, but represents a quintessential expression of how Cabernet Franc can provide penetrating aromas and flavors without the sense of force and weightiness of Cabernet Sauvignon or Merlot. With striking elegance, purity, and balance, it is reminiscent of what Cheval Blanc might taste like if it were located in the Santa Ynez Valley! It will drink well for 10-15 years.	218925	\$143.95
La Tierra de Jonata 2007, Santa Ynez – V Parker: 93 The 2007 La Tierra de Jonata ...blows away virtually every other Sangiovese made in California. High quality unsmoked cigar tobacco, cedar, sweet, meaty porcini mushrooms, cassis, cherries, and graphite are all present in the spectacular aromatics and rich, full-bodied flavors. There is not a hard edge to be found in this refreshingly vibrant, fruity red. Enjoy it over the next 3-5 years.	221150	\$84.95
Ojai Bien Nacido Syrah 2005, Santa Maria – V Parker: 93 Classic notes of graphite, tapenade, blackberries, and cassis dominate the deep ruby/purple-hued 2005 Syrah Bien Nacido Vineyard's aromatics. Structured and muscular with abundant tannins as well as superb concentration, it will benefit from several years of cellaring, and should keep for 15+.	104315	\$47.95

Trimbach Reserve Pinot Gris 2007 – VO Parker: 91 Scents of white truffle; candied lime and orange peel; and peach could also be those of a Riesling. Firm, polished, and palpably full of stuffing, yet succulent and downright refreshing in a way Alsace Pinot Gris seldom is, this brings varietally recognizable smoke and lip-smacking saline savor in its finish. As a classic (read: 'old-fashioned, dry-tasting') Alsace Pinot Gris that should drink well for at least 8-10 years, this represents an exceptional value ... and if you consider the price of white truffles, it's a steal! 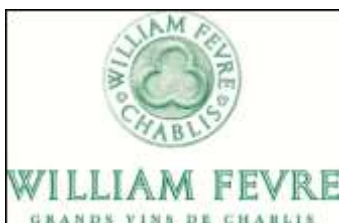

 Consider it a "super Soave" made from 100% hand-picked Garganega grapes left to dry for at least 40 days with partial barrel fermentation and oak ageing. Aromas of rich, ripe fruit and honey; voluptuous on the palate, with a persistent mineral finish, reflecting the volcanic soils of the Soave zone.

Sartori Amarone Corte Bra 2004 – V Mar 3/12 225540 \$51.95
Wine Enthusiast: 92 "is a layered and sophisticated Amarone with deep layers of black cherry, spice, leather, tobacco, steak sauce and polished black stone. It offers impressive intensity followed by a rich, velvety mouthfeel."
